Library Highlights:

- Completed the Repurpose Project in February 2015 on time and within budget. The Library relocated to the Annex in October to provide limited services during construction. The Rededicated Ceremony took place on February 28, 2015.
- A radio frequency identification system (RFID) was installed to allow for smoother check-in, checkout, and inventory procedures. This was funded by the Friends of the Churchill County Library and the Churchill Library Association.
- Received over \$14,000 in grants from Bessie Minor Swift Foundation, Raley's nickelAid, Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA), and Travel to Training funds.
- 611 participants in the Summer Reading Program.
