The library is available anytime for NaNoWriMo participants. Laurel and Joy will be on-hand to encourage and assist on the dates below.

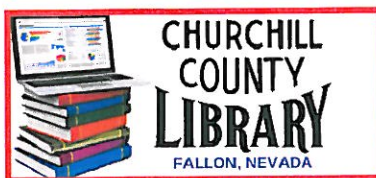
- **November 1**-Getting Started NaNoWriMo Party-Refreshments will be served
