#### Highlights:

- Received over \$16,000 in funding from Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) and Collection Development funding from the State of Nevada
- The Churchill Library Association provided over \$8,550 in funding for the Summer Reading Program, Friday STEAM programs, Books for Babies!, and author Claire Watkins.
- The library purchased over \$24,000 of materials from the Freeman and Norma Morgan Trust.

COVID-19 has had an impact on the Library and how business is conducted. For the last 8 years staff have worked hard to promote the library including programming and outreach to the community. This became a core component of library services. That abruptly ended in March. Since then staff has come up with new ways to provide library services. It has been challenging to come up

with new ways to deliver services and also inspiring to interact with staff on new ideas.

- Closed the physical library on March 16, 2020
- All in-person programming cancelled
- Patrons had 24/7 access via the website including downloadable ebooks, eaudio, and streaming video
- Curb pickup began 5/11/20
- Library by appointment began 6/8/20
- Produce story times and make them available on social media
- Put together and distributes crafts for pickup to go along with the online story time
- Produce videos to learn coding
- Interface with local child care organizations to provide library resources as appropriate
